Welcome

1. Minutes of the last meeting.

Minutes of the last meeting where agreed as an accurate reflection of the last meeting.

Carmela updated PPG members on the latest re toys for the surgery following new infection control policies from CQC. It was recommended that the surgery do not buy toys but use the monies collected towards another project for the surgery. Concerns were raised over making sure the surgery patients were aware that monies raised will go to a good cause, not toys as previously stated. It was agreed that a statement was needed to explain this on the surgery website.

 - how do clinical (and other) staff in the practice view/relate to the patient group – what works, what doesn't
 - what progress with patient surveys this year
 - what learning from last year/previous years' surveys
 - what do practices get out of the survey
 - what is the value of a virtual patient group (who has one?)
 - practice managers meet together regularly/from time to time. How will this continue when the PCT ends on 28 March
